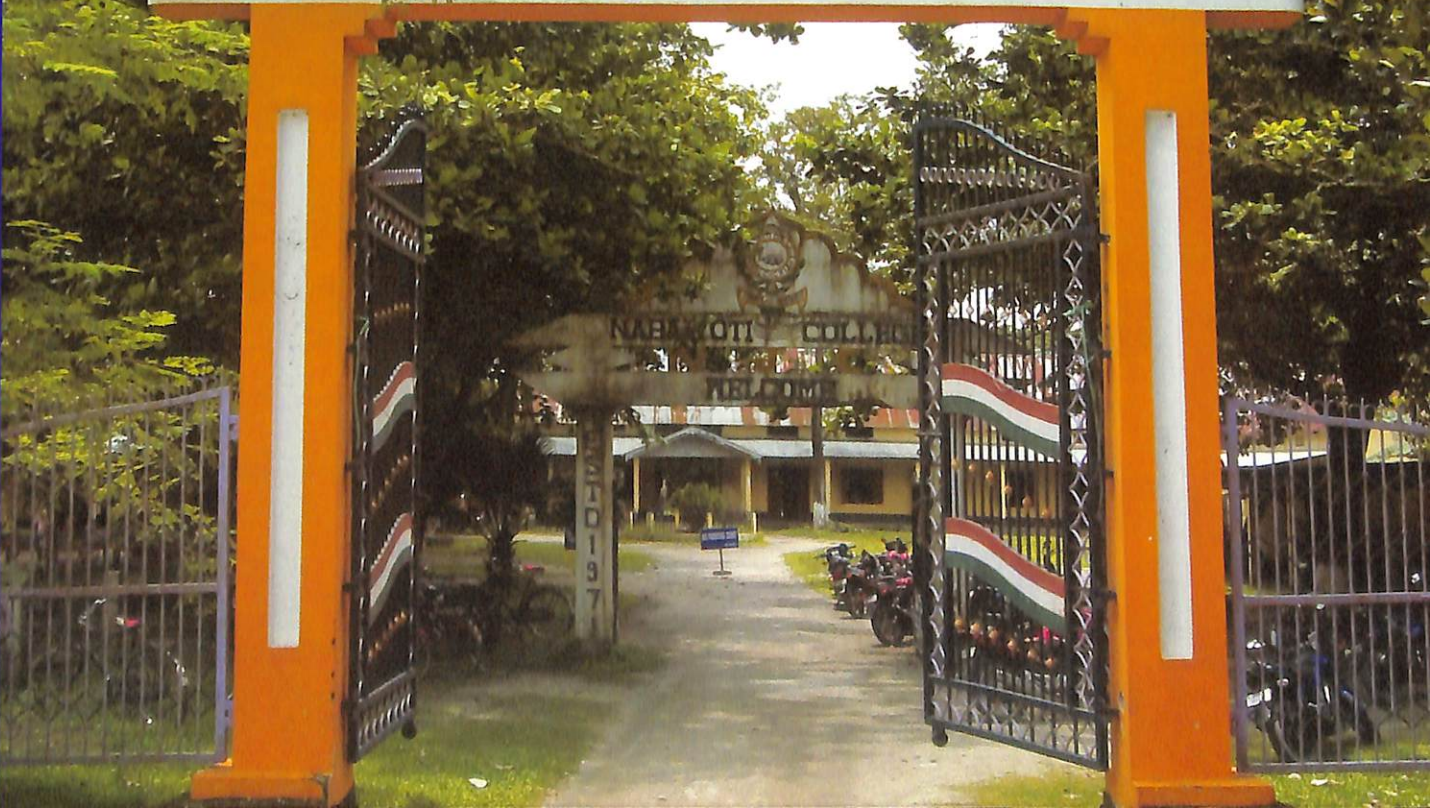

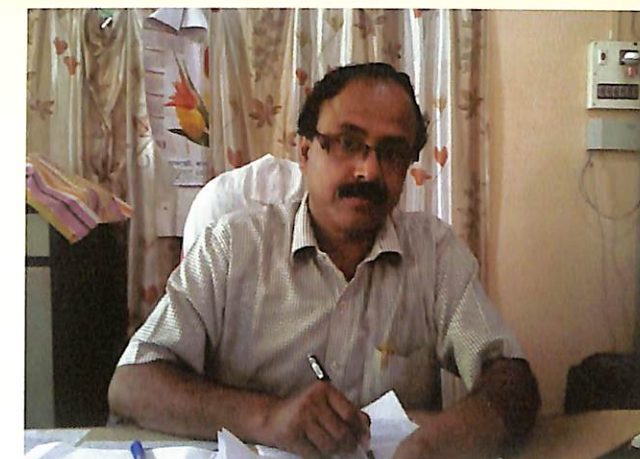

SEMESTER SYSTEM

There will be Six Semesters covering three calendar years. The schedule is as follows :

Admission	:	June
Classes for Odd Semester	:	August—December
Sessional-I	:	September
Sessional-II	:	November
Final	:	December
Classes for Even Semesters	:	January—June
Sessional-I	:	February
Sessional-II	:	April
Final	:	June
Semester Break	:	1st July to 31st July

Evaluations

Internal Evaluation	:	20% of total marks
External Evaluation	:	80% of total marks

- Internal Evaluation should be based on Sessional exams, Home Assignments, Seminars and Library Works in each Semester. External Evaluation should be through a Final Exam at the end of each Semester.
- The Pass Mark is 30% for theory and 40% for practical. Student must pass in both Internal as well as External Exams separately.
- A student who could not appear or failed in any Semester will be allowed to clear the same as follows:
 - a) Semester- I with regular Semester- III
 - b) Semester- II with regular Semester- IV
 - c) Semester- III with regular Semester- V
 - d) Semester- IV with regular Semester- VI

A student may be allowed to Repeat any one of the theory papers in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Semesters and he may be allowed for Betterment of marks in one paper in the 5th Semester only if he/she secures less than 45% marks in that paper.

No Repeat/Betterment shall be allowed in the practical exams.

A student must clear all the Semesters within five years from the date of admission to the 1st Semester Course. A student will get a maximum of three chances to clear a particular Semester.

There is no scope for a student to appear as a Private Candidate.



Additional Instruction

Semester-I and Semester-II:

- English is compulsory for BA/BSc (Major & General). But students having Major in English will have to take a different English Paper in lieu of this English Paper.
- MIL/Alt Eng is compulsory for students of BA with General and Major Course
- There is no MIL/Alt Eng for BSc students.
- For BA Major/General Course, a student shall have to choose two subjects (at least one subject must be Non-Language) in addition to MIL/Alt Eng. Out of two, one subject may be taken as Major Subject. Then other subject will be considered as 1st Subsidiary Subject and MIL/Alt Eng is taken as 2nd Subsidiary Subject. Again, in case of General Course, two subjects (other than MIL/Alt Eng) will be considered as 1st Elective and 2nd Elective Subject.
- For BA Course, a student with Language Major will offer a Non-Language Subject as subsidiary subject other than the subject he/she is Majoring. For example, English Major will offer other than Alt Eng/Elective English and Assamese Major will offer other than Assamese.**
- Students taking Major Course in BSc will have to offer two other Elective Subjects.
- Students taking General Course in BSc will have to offer three Elective Subjects.

Semester-III and Semester-IV (BSc):

- For 3rd and 4th Semester of BSc Course (General), a student will have to offer three Elective Subjects (with or without practical) each of which carries 100 marks. Environmental Studies is a Compulsory Subject in this case.

Semester-V and Semester-VI (BSc):

- For 5th and 6th Semester of BSc Course (General), a student will have to offer two Elective Subjects (with or without practical)

Eligibility and Admission to the Major Subject

Students willing to study Major in any one of the above mentioned subjects must secure at least 45% in the subject concerned in HS Final. Admission to the Major course will be strictly on the basis of merit.

Forms and Prospectus

Students should collect the Admission Form along with Prospectus and Academic Calendar from the office of the College and have to submit the same duly filled in along with necessary documents mentioned below :

1. Duly attested Photo copies of Admit Card, Mark sheets, Testimonials, Registration Card of last examination passed, Caste Certificate (in case of SC/ST/OBC/MOBC) and Gap period Certificate (if necessary)
2. Two copies of self-attested Stamp Size recent colour photograph.

General Rules

- ▶ All the students will have to pay Admission Fees and other fees at a time on the day of admission
- ▶ Students shall have to abide by the Rules and Regulations framed by the College Authority
- ▶ Wearing College Uniform for student is mandatory during College hours (Classes, Examinations, College Week, Students' Union Election, Freshmen Social, Seminar, Workshop, Independence Day, Republic Day etc.)
- ▶ Use of mobile phone is strictly prohibited within the College Campus.
- ▶ **Ragging is absolutely banned. Anybody found involving/indulging in ragging shall be punished as per law framed by the honourable Supreme Court of India.**
- ▶ Students damaging College properties, playing truancy and loitering hither and thither shall seriously be dealt with in order to maintain healthy academic atmosphere in the Campus.
- ▶ Students shall not be allowed to park their bicycles, bikes or cars beyond the parking shed of the College.
- ▶ All have to contribute to ensure pollution-free atmosphere in the Campus.
- ▶ Boarders of both the Boys' and Girls' Hostels shall have to follow the Hostel Rules and Regulations designed by the College Authority

Attendance

Every student must have at least 75% attendance in his/her classes otherwise he/she will lose studentship as per AHSEC and GU Rules.

Hostels

Both Boys and Girls can avail Hostel facilities. There are two separate hostels for boys and girls run by two separate management Committee. There are 100 seats for boys and 65 for girls. Student shall have to apply for Hostel in prescribed form. Admission into Hostel will be on the basis of merit. A three-storied Girls' Hostel with 100 seats is being constructed.



Library

Besides departmental libraries there is a Central Library of the College with rich collection of text books, reference books, journals, magazines, and news papers. Students can avail library facilities during College hours. Moreover, a Book Bank has been established to help the economically deprived students. During summer vacations the library remains open and students can avail the facilities of it. Every student will be given a Library Card against which he/she can borrow two books at a time. 120 students can read at a time inside the library reading room. Xerox facility is available in the Library at concessional rate for students. Newly constructed library reading room for 100 students is going to be opened very soon.

Canteen

Students may have their refreshment from the College Canteen.

Guest House

There is a Guest House in the College. Parents/Guardians of the student can stay in the Guest House while visiting their wards. Moreover, any visiting Government officials, Distinguished Professors of Universities/Colleges whoever comes to the College on duty or on tour and desires to stay in the Guest House shall be accommodated with. There is a rest house for the Alumni of the College.

Cycle Stand and Car Parking

Two big Sheds have been arranged separately for Cycle Stand and Car Parking. Students may safely keep their bicycles. Motor bikes/Cars of the teachers, employees and visitors may be parked conveniently in the Car Parking Shed.

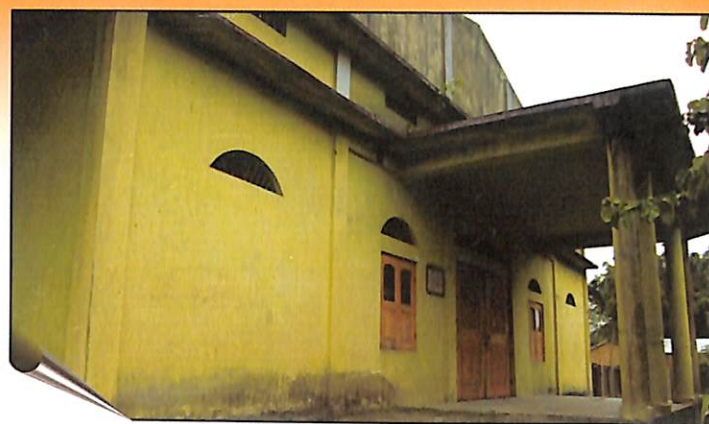
