

SEMESTER SYSTEM

There will be Six Semesters covering three calendar years. The schedule is as follows

Admission : June

Classes for Odd Semesters : August-December

Sessional-I : September
Sessional-II : November
Final : December

Classes for Even Semesters : January-June

Sessional-I : February
Sessional-II : April
Final : June

Semester Break : 1st July to 31st July

Evaluations

Internal Evaluation : 20% of total marks
External Evaluation : 80% of total marks

- Internal Evaluation should be based on Sessional exams, Home Assignments, Seminars and Library Works in each Semester. External Evaluation should be through a Final Exam at the end of each Semester.
- The Pass Mark is 30% for theory and 40% for practical. Student must pass in both Internal as well as External Exams separately.
- A student who could not appear or failed in any Semester will be allowed to clear the same as follows:
 - a) Semester-I with regular Semester-III
 - b) Semester-II with regular Semester-IV
 - c) Semester-III with regular Semester-V
 - d) Semester-IV with regular Semester-VI
- A student may be allowed to Repeat any one of theory papers in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Semesters and he may be allowed for Betterment of marks in one paper in the 5th Semester only if he/she secures less than 45% marks in that paper.
- No Repeat/Betterment shall be allowed in the practical exams
- A student must clear all the Semesters within five year from the date of admission to the 1st Semester Course. A student will get maximum three chances to clear a particular Semester.
- There is no scope for a student to appear as a Private Candidate

Additional Instruction

Semester-I and Semester-II:

- 1. English is compulsory for BA/BSc (Major & General). But students having Major in English will have to take a different English Paper in lieu of this English Paper.
- 2. MIL/Alt Eng is compulsory for students of BA with General and Major Course
- 3. There is no MIL/Alt Eng for BSc students.
- 4. For BA Major/General Course, a student shall have to choose two subjects (at least one subject must be Non-Language) in addition to MIL/Alt Eng. Out of two, one subject may be taken as Major Subject. Then other subject will be considered as 1st Subsidiary Subject and MIL/Alt Eng is taken as 2nd Subsidiary Subject. Again, in case of General Course, two subjects (other than MIL/Alt Eng) will be considered as 1st Elecive and 2nd Elective Subject.
- 5. In case of MIL/Alt Eng (2nd Subsidiary Subject for BA Course, a student with Language Major will offer a Non-Language Subject other than the Subject he/she is Majoring. For example English Major will offer other than Alt Eng/Elective English and Assamese Major will offer other than Assamese
- 6. Students taking Major Course in BSc will have to offer other two Elective Subjects.
- 7. Students taking General Course in BSc will have to offer three Elective Subjects.
- 8. Change of Major Subject is not allowed after Semester-I

Semester-III and Semester-IV (BSc):

 For 3rd and 4th Semester of BSc Course (General), a student will have to offer three Elective Subjects (with or without practical) each of which carries 100 marks. Environment Studies is a Compulsory Subject in this case.

Semester-V and Semester-VI (BSc):

10. For 5th and 6th Semester of BSc Course (General), a student will have to offer two Elective Subjects (with or without practical)

There will be 20% reservation for the students of Nabayoti College for both Major & General courses in order of merit.

Quota System will be maintained as per Govt. Norms for SC/ST/OBC/MOBC in open to all eligible candidates.

The Central Library

The Central Library of the College is enriched with more than 20,000 books and reference collections. Besides, there are 7 subject related journals and a good collection of Magazines. The Library is having 6 daily and 2 weekly Newspapers along with the bound volumes. The user can access the whole database of the Library through OPAC (Open Public Access Catalogue) facility. Students can avail the Library facilities during the College hours. Moreover, 'Book Bank' facility is also extended to economically poor students. The Library Membership will be provided to the students after submitting the prescribed membership form. Xerox facility is also made available at concessional rate for students. The Library remains open even during Summer Vacation.

Library Rules

- 1. A student of Major/general course can borrow 3 and 2 books respectively at a time
- 2. Books will be issued for a period of 15 days.
- The students can renew the Library books two times in a year.
- 4. An overdue @ 25 paisa per day will be charged if he/she fails to return the books in time
- 5. In case of lost of Library Card, an application should be given to the Librarian and will be charged Rs. 40/- for issuing a duplicate Card.






