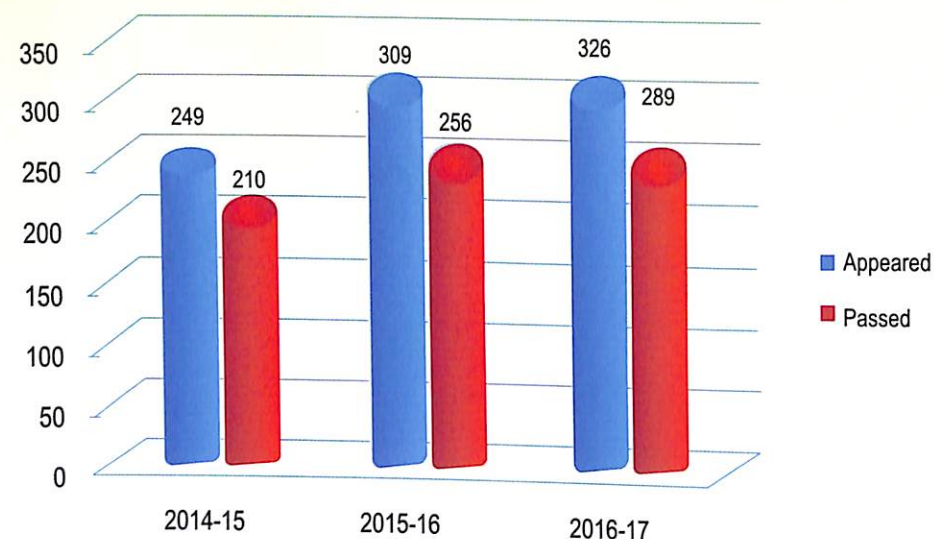

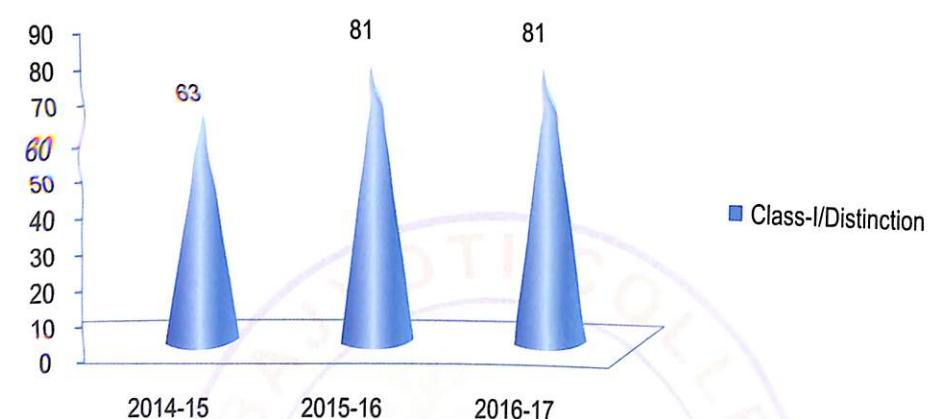

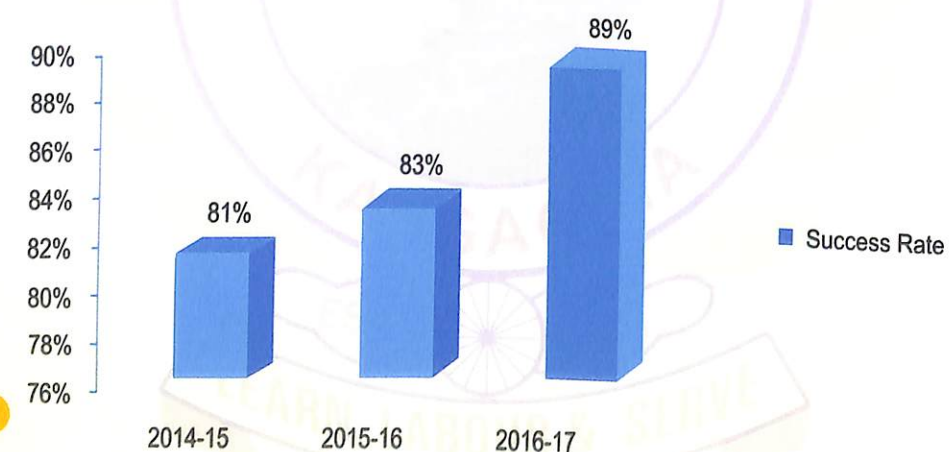

## Semester System

There will be Six Semesters covering three calendar years. The schedule is as follows

### Admission:

Classes for Odd Semesters	: June
Sessional	: August—December
Final	: October
Classes for Even Semesters	: December
Sessional	: January—June
Final	: April

(Students have to follow the Academic Calendar)

### Evaluations:

Internal Evaluation (Sessional)	: 20% of total marks
External Evaluation (Final)	: 80% of total marks

### Breaking of Sessional Marks:

Written Test	: 80% of total Sessional Marks
Seminars, Attendance, Home Assignments	: 20% of total Sessional Marks

Internal Evaluation should be based on Sessional exams, Home Assignments, Seminars and Library Works in each Semester. External Evaluation should be through a Final Exam at the end of each Semester.

The Pass Mark is 30% for theory and 40% for practical. Student must pass in both Sessional as well as External Exams separately.

A student who could not appear or failed in any Semester will be allowed to clear the same as follows:

- Semester-I with regular Semester-III
- Semester-II with regular Semester-IV
- Semester-III with regular Semester-V
- Semester-IV with regular Semester-VI

A student may be allowed to Repeat any one of theory papers in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Semesters and he/she may be allowed for Betterment of marks in one paper in the 5th Semester only if he/she secures less than 45% marks in that paper.

No Repeat/Betterment shall be allowed in the practical exams

A student must clear all the Semesters within five years from the date of admission to the 1st Semester Course. A student will get maximum three chances to clear a particular Semester.

There is no scope for a student to appear as a Private Candidate

## Additional Instruction:

### Semester-I and Semester-II:

- English is compulsory for BA/BSc (Major & General). But students having Major in English will have to take a different Paper in lieu of this English Paper.
- MIL/Alt Eng is compulsory for students of BA with General and Major Course
- There is no MIL/Alt Eng for BSc students.
- For BA Major/General Course, a student shall have to choose two subjects (at least one subject must be Non-Language) in addition to MIL/Alt Eng. Out of two, one subject may be taken as Major Subject. Then other subject will be considered as 1st Subsidiary Subject and MIL/Alt Eng is taken as 2nd Subsidiary Subject. Again, in case of General Course, two subjects (other than MIL/Alt Eng) will be considered as 1st Elective and 2nd Elective Subject.
- In case of MIL/Alt Eng (2nd Subsidiary Subject for BA Course, a student with Language Major will offer a Non-Language Subject other than the Subject he/she is Majoring. For example English Major will offer other than Alt Eng/Elective English and Assamese Major will offer other than Assamese
- Students taking Major Course in BSc will have to offer other two Elective Subjects.
- Students taking General Course in BSc will have to offer three Elective Subjects.
- Change of Major Subject is not allowed after Semester-I

### Semester-III and Semester-IV (BSc):

- For 3rd and 4th Semester of BSc Course (General), a student will have to offer three Elective Subjects (with or without practical) each of which carries 100 marks. Environment Studies is a Compulsory Subject in this case.

### Semester-V and Semester-VI (BSc):

- For 5th and 6th Semester of BSc Course (General), a student will have to offer two Elective Subjects (with or without practical)

## Eligibility and Admission to the Major Subject

For admission into Major Course a student must

- Secure 50% in the subject concerned in HS Final Exam
- Secure pass mark in Mathematics in HS Final Exam for Major in Physics and Chemistry
- Sit for Entrance Test conducted by the College

There is an option to appear in two Entrance Tests of the College provided he/she submits two Application Forms (The first one with yellow colour being first choice for Major and the second one with blue colour being the second choice for Major) duly filled in seeking specific subject as Major. The selected candidate will finally be allowed in any one of the Major Subjects that he/she opts for. Filled up form should be submitted in the respective Department.

- The two application forms enclosed with the prospectus can only be used by single applicant.
- Any fraudulent attempt in matters of seeking admission will lead to the cancellation of the application and also the applicant will be liable to legal punishment.

## General Rules

- \* All the students will have to pay Admission Fees and other fees at a time on the day of admission.
- \* Students shall have to abide by the Rules and Regulations framed by the College Authority
- \* Wearing College Uniform for student is mandatory during College hours (Classes, Examinations, College Week, Students' Union Election, Freshmen Social, Seminar, Workshop, Independence Day, Republic Day etc.)

### Attendance

Every student must have at least 75% attendance in his/her classes otherwise he/she will lose studentship as per AHSEC and GU Rules.

### Hostels

Both Boys and Girls can avail Hostel facilities. There are two separate hostels for boys and girls run by two separate Management Committees. There are 100 seats for boys, 65 for girls. Students shall have to apply for Hostels in prescribed form. Admission into Hostel will be on the basis of merit. A three-storied Girls' Hostel with 100 seats is being constructed.

### Canteen

The College has a very nice and hygienic canteen having all types of refreshment at affordable price. All teachers/ staffs/students/ alumni / parents can access to it except outsider.



### Drinking Water

There is well treated drinking water facility for all. Students can drink Mineral water from RO Plants installed in six different corners. We expect students not to use RO water for any purpose other than drinking

### Lavatory

There are sufficient hygienic Washrooms for both boys and girls separately with running water facilities. It is our duty to keep it clean for other's use.
