
### Issue of Prospectus with Admission Form

- \* There will be 5% relaxation in aggregate marks to the Applicants passing out from Nabajyoti College and also Candidates of reserved categories.





### Semester System

There will be Six Semesters covering three calendar years. The schedule is as follows

<b>Admission</b>	: June
Classes for Odd Semesters	: August—December
Sessional	: October
Final	: November/December
Classes for Even Semesters	: January—June
Sessional	: April+
Final	: May/June

(Students have to follow the Academic Calendar)

#### Evaluations

Internal Evaluation (Sessional)	: 20% of total marks
External Evaluation (Final)	: 80% of total marks

#### Breaking of Sessional Marks

Written Test	: 80% of total Sessional Marks
Seminars, Attendance, Home Assignments	: 20% of total Sessional Marks

Internal Evaluation should be based on Sessional Exams, Home Assignments, Seminars and Library Works in each Semester. External Evaluation should be through a Final Exam at the end of each Semester.

The Pass Mark is 30% for theory and 40% for practical. Student must pass in both Sessional as well as External Exams separately.

A student who could not appear or failed in any Semester will be allowed to clear the same as follows:

- Semester-I with regular Semester-III
- Semester-II with regular Semester-IV
- Semester-III with regular Semester-V
- Semester-IV with regular Semester-VI

A student may be allowed to Repeat any one of theory papers in the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th Semesters and he/she may be allowed for Betterment of marks in one paper in the 5th Semester only if he/she secures less than 45% marks in that paper.

No Repeat/Betterment shall be allowed in the practical exams

Students of 6th Semester having arrear subjects in 2nd Semester will not be allowed to appear in both the Semesters. They are entitled to appear either in the 2nd Semester or in 6th Semester only

A student must clear all the Semesters within five years from the date of admission to the 1st Semester Course. A student will get maximum three chances to clear a particular Semester.

There is no scope for a student to appear as a Private Candidate.





### Additional Instruction

#### Semester-I and Semester- II :

- ▶ English is compulsory for BA/BSc (Major & General). But students having Major in English will have to take a different Paper in lieu of this English Paper.
- ▶ MIL/Alt Eng is compulsory for students of BA with General and Major Course
- ▶ There is no MIL/Alt Eng for BSc students.
- ▶ For BA Major/General Course, a student shall have to choose two subjects (at least one subject must be Non–Language) in addition to MIL/Alt Eng. Out of two, one subject may be taken as Major Subject. Then other subject will be considered as 1st Subsidiary Subject and MIL/Alt Eng is taken as 2nd Subsidiary Subject. Again, in case of General Course, two subjects (other than MIL/Alt Eng) will be considered as 1st Elective and 2nd Elective Subject.
- ▶ In case of MIL/Alt Eng (2nd Subsidiary Subject for BA Course, a student with Language Major will offer a Non–Language Subject other than the Subject he/she is Majoring. For example English Major will offer other than Alt Eng/Elective English and Assamese Major will offer other than Assamese


- ▶ Students taking Major Course in BSc will have to offer other two Elective Subjects.
- ▶ Students taking General Course in BSc will have to offer three Elective Subjects.
- ▶ Change of Major Subject is not allowed after Semester–I Semester–III and Semester–IV (BSc):

#### Semester-V and Semester-VI (Bsc):

- ▶ For 3rd and 4th Semester of BSc Course (General), a student will have to offer three Elective Subjects(with or without practical) each of which carries 100 marks. Environment Studies is a Compulsory Subject in this case.

#### Semester-V and Semester-VI (Bsc):

- ▶ For 5th and 6th Semester of BSc Course (General), a student will have to offer two Elective Subjects (with or without practical)




## ANTI-RAGGING IS OUR PRINCIPLE
