The Central Library

The Central Library of Nabajyoti College was established since the inception of the college as its integral part. Since the beginning it has continuously strived for growth and excellence and it is now boasts of being a well equipped library enriched with more than 26,000 books. The library is a registered member of the Online Database NList under INFLIBNET Centre (Information and Library Network), Ahmedabad- an UIC of UGC. Students are provided with an unique username and password to access NList, facilitated by the librarian. There are different sections inside the library viz Reading Room Section, Stack Area Section, Periodical Section and Reference Section etc. It provides a strong support in terms of Library and Information Services to its user fraternity within the campus. The Library is open to the Students, Faculty and Staff of the college. The library conducts user orientation programs for new students every year to make them familiar with its resources and functioning with the intention of optimal utilization. For guiding the users to initiate and adapt to newer and latest online learning platforms, the library has been taking initiative to produce comprehensive Audio Visual manuals from time to time.

The library has been continuously acquiring and updating itself with all the latest updates regarding plagiarism, how to write references, how to check citations, how to search internet and what are the basic e resources etc. for dissemination to the users.

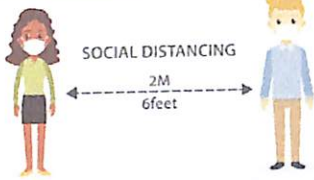
