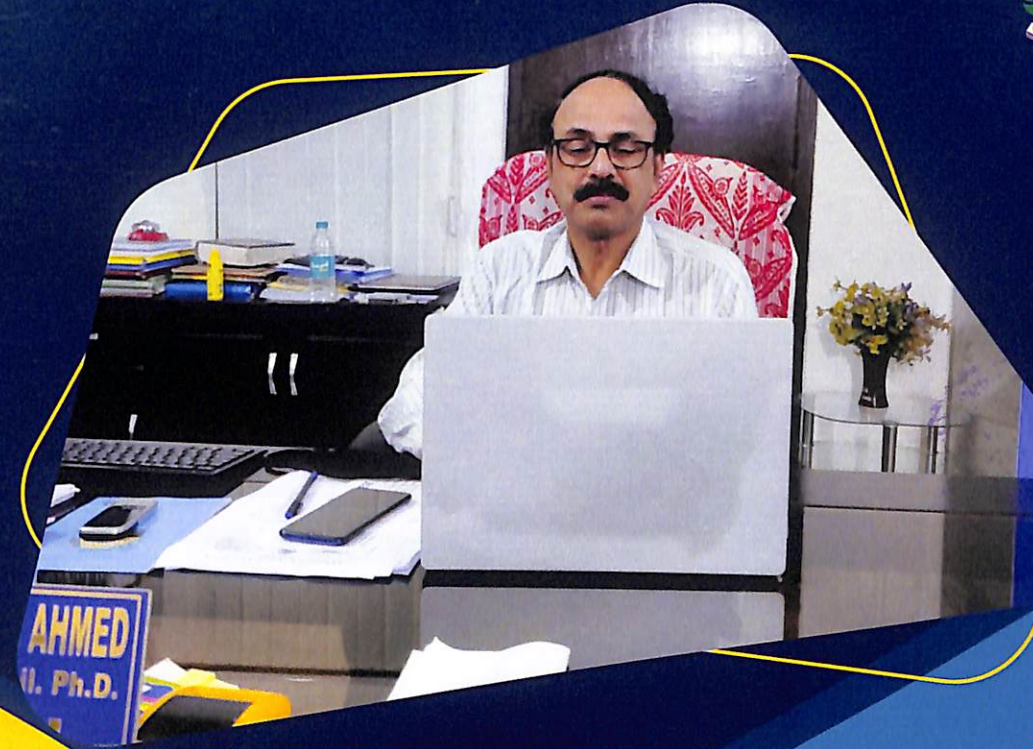

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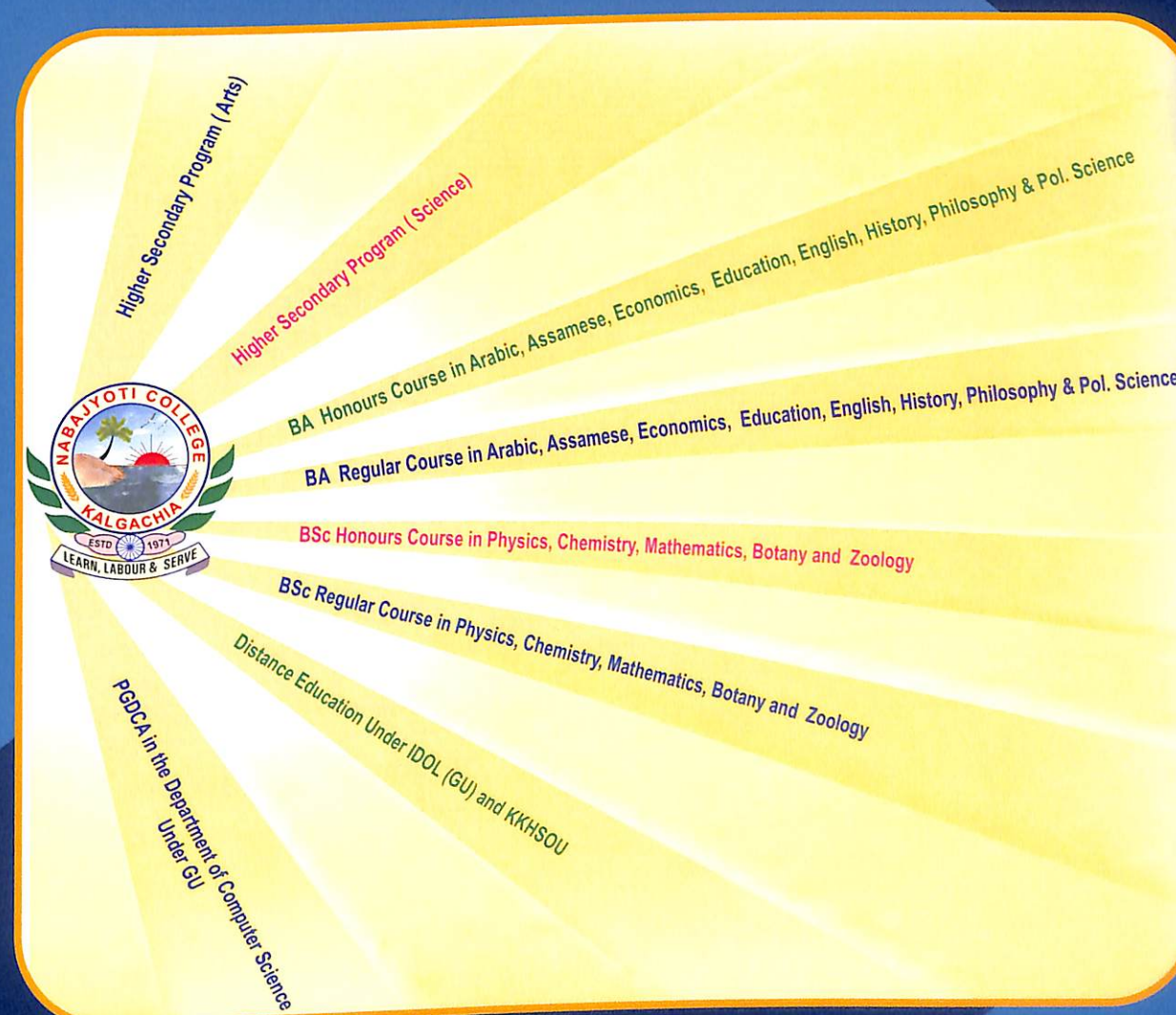
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## Nabajyoti at a Glance

The library is open to the students, faculty and staff of the College. The library conducts user orientation programmes for the new students every year to make them familiar with its resources and functioning with the intention of optimal utilization. For guiding the users to initiate and adapt to newer and latest online platforms, the library has been taking initiative to produce comprehensive audio visual manuals from time to time.

As part of library automation the Central library has adopted the ILMS (SOUL2.0) wherein the database of all the book collection is converted to computerized format. The library regularly updates the bibliographic data as per the standard format. In an initiative to upgrade the existing infrastructure to adopt RFID technology the College library has installed the RFID gate and its ancillary components to serve the intended purpose and other remaining works are in final stage of completion.
